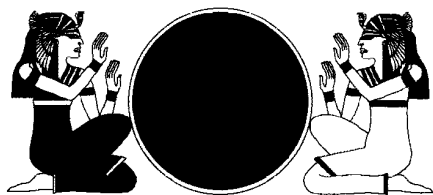


Temple of the Dark Moon



Correspondence Course on Magick, Wicca and Wytchcraft

The Temple of the Dark Moon believes that if a person has a genuine interest in the ancient teachings of Magick, Wicca and Wytchcraft that these teachings should be available to them. Due to the various interpretations of these ancient teachings, the Temple has devised a correspondence course written specifically from the Southern Hemispheric perspective. This course consists of 13 comprehensive lectures, with the complete course containing over 200 pages.

Due to the structure of the correspondence course, the onus is on the student to proceed with the lectures only when they believe they have a firm understanding of what is being taught.

Through the study of these lectures, the student will obtain knowledge into the ancient teachings of Magick, Wicca and Wytchcraft. Each lecture contains exercises for the student to practice and a

questionnaire which should be completed and returned to the Temple. All information contained within the questionnaires is treated as confidential.

As the progress of the student is monitored by the questionnaires, should students have any problems with the lectures, they should contact the Temple.

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Lectures of the Correspondence Course

The lectures contained within the Temple of the Dark Moon's correspondence course include:

- Introduction to Paganism (free lecture).
- Origins of Magick and Wytchcraft.
- Getting to Know Thy Self and Setting up a Sacred Space.
- Meditation and Visualisation.
- Working Tools and the Elements.
- Ritual Work and Circle Casting in the Southern Hemisphere.
- The Seasonal Wheel of the Year.
- The Triple Goddess - Maiden, Mother and Crone.
- Defence of the Horned God.
- Auras and Chakra Work.
- Magickal Correspondences & Natural Magick.
- Understanding White, Grey and Black magick.
- Writing Rituals and Spell Casting.

Also provided within this correspondence course is a seven part dictionary on occult terms (available from Lecture 2).

Upon completion of the correspondence course, students should have extensive knowledge of the ancient teachings of Magick, Wicca and Wytchcraft to confidentially practise as a solitary or to the level of "First Degree".

A "Certificate of Completion" is presented to students who complete this course.

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What is in the name ...

In the ancient teachings, the Dark Moon represented the subconscious level of our being, and it is at this level that the hidden, or forgotten, knowledge that has been passed down through the ages, can be found.

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Fees and Structure of the Course

This course is offered in two different formats. The original format is by post where, after the first free lecture, the cost per lecture is \$20.00. Alternatively, if the course is paid in full, a substantial discount is offered.

An alternative format is to receive the course lectures by email pdf documents. The fee for this format is \$35.00 for three lecture blocks. The lectures are still sent individually along with reminders when the next payment is due.

Every lecture received by the Temple of the Dark Moon is marked individually by

our High Priestess with any additional information provided free of charge. A student cannot progress with the course unless that they have had the previous lecture marked.

A time frame of three months is given between lectures. If the Temple has not heard from a student after this time, their file closed. Should a student wish to continue their study after this time, they should notify the Temple of their desire to resume with their studies. Any outstanding questionnaires should be completed and payment for the next lecture included.

The Temple of the Dark Moon regularly donates a percentage of all moneys received from its courses to various ecological and environmental organisations.

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The Founder ...

When Frances Billingham founded the Temple of the Dark Moon in 1999, she had already been studying metaphysical and occult subjects for a number of years. While her initial magickal training was largely in Hermetic (ceremonial) Magic, Frances is also an initiated Wytch and priestess of the Alexandrian Wicca tradition.

Since 1998 Frances has been writing on Pagan related subjects, and from 2002 for "Insight" magazine, Australia's No. 1 Spiritual life style magazine. Her articles have appeared in numerous publications world wide including "Witchcraft Magazine" (Aus), "The Cauldron" (UK), "Sage Woman"

(US), Rainbow News" (NZ) and "Llewellyn's 2008 Witch's Calendar" (USA).

In 2003 Frances spoke at the New Zealand Pagan festival where she also performed the opening ritual with Chief Druid, Phillip Carr Gomm. In 2004 she presented a lecture at the Adelaide Pagan Conference, and has been a guest speaker at the Pagans in the Pub forum (Adelaide) on a number of occasions.

From 2000 until 2006 Frances held the volunteer position of Secretary for Pagan Alliance Inc (South Australia) until she resigned from that organisation. She is also a member of the Fellowship of Isis (Ireland), the Pagan Federation (UK), and Builders of the Adytum.

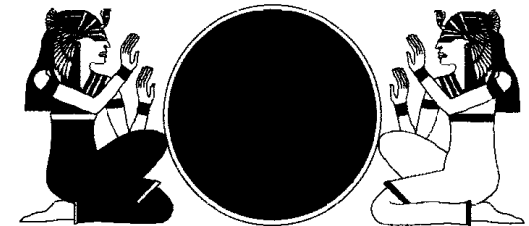
