

Wicca and Magick Study Circle



With many books and internet sites available on Wicca, it can often be confusing for the novice to ascertain whether such information accurately relates to the religious as well as the magickal practices of Wicca.

To assist in this understanding, as well as how Wicca practices relate to the Southern Hemisphere, a practical "Wicca & Magick Study Circle" will commence in August 2009.

Taken from a more traditional Wicca perspective, each month particular aspects of the Wiccan religion will be explained by an experienced Wiccan High Priestess. Relying on personal experience, the knowledge shared will prove invaluable for those interested in following the Wiccan religion.

The focus of this study circle will centre around practical application – that is, the creation of ritual and the crafting of magick, as well as some basic theory with respect to Wicca as a religion. During the course of the circle, participants will learn:

- ❖ The Southern Wheel of the Year – the sacred festivals for the Southern Hemisphere.

- ❖ Writing and working ritual as a group as well as solitary workings.
